# The 1840 Craven County, North Carolina Federal Census

This transcription's goal was to produce a modern format version, faithful to the original, fully indexed, and in a WYSIWYG format. The images were transcribed to a relational database, and the output has been formatted to a facsimile of the original pages.

The original spelling of names in the document has been preserved. The comprehensive indexing of surnames is intended to overcome any difficulties in the original spelling. Also many names are now spelled differently by ancestors and the correct or modern spelling of names is left to the user of this work.

All of the names on Schedule 4 appear in the Index. Due to differences in the original spelling, the index should be examined for other common spellings of a surname, i.e., Withrington, Weatherington, Wetherington, etc.

## Schedule 4 – Schedule of All Persons

The 1840 Federal Census included the name of head of household along with ages and statistics on the family and or occupants. No other names in the household are listed.

The county was enumerated in three districts: **(NSN)** North and East of Neuse River, **(NB)** New Bern, and **(SSN)** South Side Neuse River. The pages were not dated.

The North and East Side of the Neuse River was enumerated by Charles Kelley. The remaining two districts were enumerated by James Hayward.

The 1840 boundaries on the map are in black and are approximate. The current 2000 boundaries are in grey.
