Tract of Land, situate, lying, & being in the County of Craven aforesd, on the North side of the upper Broad Creek, on the N: Side of Newe River, containing one hundred Acres, be the same more or less, & bounded Viz: Beginning at the mouth of a Branch below my Plantation, & running up the Branch, by a Line of marked Trees, to the same, & down the Line, to the beginning, at the mouth of running Branch, it being part, of a greater quantity, granted by Patent, in the year 1748; To have & to hold, the said granted, & bargained premises, with all the appurtenances, privileges, & commodities, to the same belonging, or in any wise, or pertaining, to him the said Christopher Dawson, his heirs & assigns for ever; to his & their only proper use, benefit & behoof for ever; And, the said, William Whitford, for me, my heirs, Exec: & Admin'r, do covenant, promise & grant, to the said Christopher Dawson, his heirs & assigns, that before the Ensealing hereof, I am the Lawful Owner of the above bargained premises, & am lawfully possessed by Patent, as my own proper right, as a good, perfect, & absolute Estate of Inheritance, in fee simple, and
