whereof I do hereby acknowledge and my self thereof and of every part
and parcel thereof am satisfied and contented, and thereof and of every
part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the said Isaac Barinton
his Heirs, Executors, Administrators for ever by these Presents, Have
Given, Granted, Sold, Alien'd, Conveyed and Confirmed to him the said
Isaac Barinton his heirs, and Assigns for ever, One Messuage or Tract
of Land Situate lying and being in the County of Craven aforesaid. And
on the North side of Nuse River as a Line beginning at a Pine
near his Old line and runs S. 83. West 140 Poles to a Pine in the
edge of the Glade, then North 46 poles to a Pine in Shivers line then
to the first Station containing two hundred Acres of Land, To Have
and To Hold the said Granted and Bargained Premises with the
Appurtenances, Privileges, and Commodities to the same belonging
or in anywise appertaining, to him the said Isaac Barinton, his
Heirs and Assigns for ever, And I the said William Bastin Whitford
for me my heirs, Executors Adm^r. Do Covenant Promise and Grant
and bind with the said Isaac Barinton his Heirs and Assigns, that
before the Executing hereof I am the true and Lawful Owner of
the above bargained Premises, and am Lawfully Possessed as by Statute
as mine own proper Right of Inheritance in fee simple and have
in myself Good right full Power and Lawful Authority to Grant
bargain, Sell and Convey and Confirm the said bargained Premises, in
Manner above. And the said Isaac Barinton his Heirs and Assigns
shall and may from Time to Time, and at all times for ever hereafter
by force and Virtue of these Presents Lawfully and Peaceably & Quietly
have, hold, Use, Occupy, Possess and Enjoy, the said Tenured, and
Bargained Premises with the Appurtenances, free and clear, and freely
and clearly acquitted and Discharged off from all, and all manner of
other Gifts, Grants, Bargains, Sales, Leases, Mortgages, Wills, Intails,
Jointures, Doweries, Judgments Executions, or Innumbrances, and
Exactions: Furthermore I the said William Bastin Whitford, for my self
