KNOW YE, That We, for and in consideration of the sum of *Fifty Shillings* for every hundred acres hereby granted, paid into our treasury by *Charles Anderson* have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said *Charles Anderson* a tract of land containing

*one hundred and fifty* acres, lying and being in the county of *Craven* on the north side of *New River* and on the south side of *Swifts Creek* joining on said creek, Beginning at a sweet gum on the creek bank which is *Henry Harris's* corner and runs with his line south twenty five West two hundred and forty poles to a stake said to be *Harris's 2<sup>nd</sup>* corner, then with his other line south twenty seven East one hundred and seven poles to a stake, then south sixty seven West thirty three poles to a stake in or near *Jonas Anderson's* line then with his line North thirty two West one hundred poles to three pines said *Anderson's* corner, then North thirty West seventy poles ~~thence East~~ to a pine *Benjamin Tullington's* beginning corner, then North Eighteen East one hundred poles, thence south seventy two East twenty poles, thence south Eighteen East one hundred and sixty poles to the creek *poisson*, then with the windings of said *poisson* to the Beginning. Entered *14<sup>th</sup> Sept* 1809.

As by the plat hereunto annexed doth appear, together with all woods, waters, mines, minerals, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said land belonging or appertaining: TO HOLD to the said *Charles Anderson* heirs and assigns forever: Yielding and paying to us such sums of money, yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from time to time may direct: PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said grantee shall cause this grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said county of *Craven* within twelve months from the date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void.
