This Indenture made this eightth day of January one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Henry Anderson of the County of Craven and State of North Carolina on the one part and William Morris of County and State of aforesaid on the other part, Witnesseth that the said Henry Anderson for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Morris at the time of executing these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold conveyed alieneed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell convey alien and confirm unto the said William Morris his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land in the County and State aforesaid beginning at a pine usually called Charles Andersons corner at the ditch on Hog Savanna Bay Push then North to Seths Wetheringtons line and with his line to Reuben Andersons line with Reuben Andersons line to a lightwood stake on the South side of Reuben Andersons Mill pond called the Kemps corner South fifty seven (77) 180 poles to a pine on Millers Island then with said Henry Andersons line to his corner thence to the first station containing one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, To have and to hold to the said William Morris his heirs and assigns forever, And I the said Henry Anderson for myself and my heirs do covenant and agree to and with the said William Morris his heirs and assigns that I have a good right and absolute and full authority to grant bargain and sell the premises hereby granted bargained and sold in fee simple and that the said premises are free and clear of all incumbrances which title I warrant and defend, In witness whereof I herunto set my hand and seal the day and date above written.
