To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting,
Know ye, that no, for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds
for every hundred acres hereby granted, paid into our Treasury by Thomas
G. Townsille have given and granted, and by these presents do give and
grant unto the said Thomas G. Townsille a tract of land containing thirty
Acres, lying and being in our County of Curran on the South side of New River
and East side of Cow Creek beginning at a Small Gum or Cuts line on the
side of the South side of Hundley Branch then running South Eighty
five degrees West four poles to his own line patented by John Townsille
Senior thence along that line South forty degrees West One hundred
and thirty six poles to a pine tree in Curran thence his other line South twenty
six East Seventy six poles to Small line thence with his line to the
first Station as by the plat hereunto annexed doth appear together
with all woods, tenancy, mines, minerals, hereditaments and appurtenances,
to the said lands belonging or appertaining, To Hold to the said
Thomas G. Townsille his heirs and assigns forever. Yielding and pay-
ing to us such sum of money yearly as other wise or our General
Assembly from time to time may direct. Provided always, that the
said Thomas G. Townsille shall cause this Grant to be registered
in the Register Office of our said County of Curran within twelve
Months from the date hereof, other wise the same shall be void
