


Witnesseth that the said Peter Anderson for and in consideration of the sum of Forty pounds Proclamation money to him in hand paid at and before the Ensealing & delivery of these presents by Henry Anderson the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge myself thereunto fully satisfied and contented hath bargained, sold, assigned and set over and by these presents bargain sell assigned and set over unto the said Henry Anderson his Heirs and assigns for ever a part of tract of land containing one hundred and thirty three acres lying and being in Craven County in the State of North Carolina and on the North side of Newe River and South side Swifts Creek beginning at a pine running from thence South sixty West one hundred and thirty six poles to a pine, North twenty seven West one hundred and sixty three poles to a pine North sixty East one hundred and thirty eight poles to a pine

thence to the beginning together with all Houses Buildings Orchard Gardens  
 Wood Land, Ground and all and all manner of Rents profits appurtenances  
 Conveniences thereunto belonging or appertaining and the Reversion and  
 Reversions and Remainders Rent and profits and all the Estate rights

 in and to the said Land Premises and every and parcel thereof To Have
