To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That We, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds for every hundred acres hereby granted, paid into our treasury by: Thomas Anderson have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Thomas Anderson a tract of land containing

Eighty two acres, lying and being in the county of Craven on the south side of Swifts Creek and in Piney Creek, Beginning at a point his own corner of Gerard Johnsons patent running with the same south fifty five degrees west one hundred and twenty seven feet to a small black jack, then North sixty eight degrees west sixty six feet to a pine, then North thirty five degrees East one hundred and seventy four feet, then South thirty five degrees East one hundred and eighteen feet to the Beginning

as by the plat hereunto annexed doth appear, together with all woods, waters, mines, minerals, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said land belonging or appertaining: TO HOLD to the said Thomas Anderson heirs and assigns forever: Yielding and paying to us such sums of money, yearly, or otherwise, as our General Assembly from time to time may direct. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That the said grantee shall cause this grant to be registered in the Register's Office of our said county of Craven within twelve months from the date hereof, otherwise the same shall be void.
