This Indenture made the fifth day of February in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Thomas Anderson Senr. of the County of Craven and State of North Carolina planter of the one part and Thomas Anderson Junr. of the same place a Cooper of the other part. Witnesseth that in consideration of the love and natural affection which I bear to my son Thomas Anderson Junr. have given granted and do by these presents give and grant to the aforesaid Thomas Anderson a certain piece or parcel of land situate laying and being in aforesaid County of Craven and on the South side of Swifts Creek and in the bay bush Island it being the whole of a patent granted to the aforesaid Thomas Anderson Senr. bearing date the

containing Ninety Six acres.

To have and hold the aforesaid premises with all and singular the rights and privileges thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto unto him the said Thomas Anderson Junr. his heirs executors administrators or assigns forever. And I the said Thomas Anderson Senr. do hereby convey all the right title and interest I have in



the aforesaid land to him the aforesaid Thomas
